<p><b>SWAC</b> The Sex Worker Advisory Committee meets one Friday a month. This committee, comprised of BIPOC current and former sex workers, reports to and advises the board of directors in making decisions that uphold our ethics and support our community.</p>	
<p><b>Occupational Health and Safety Workshop</b> The Occupational Health and Safety Workshop is held each Monday and Wednesday excluding holidays. Next current cohort starts in 2025.
